THE LESSON

Acting Out Some, Some More and Some, Some Went Away Stories

- Seat the children in a semicircle on the floor.
 - "Today you will learn how to act out stories using our teddy bears."
 - "We are going to pretend that the teddy bears are going to the movies."
 - "What different things do you see at the movie theater?"
 - "What else is at a movie theater?" chairs, food, etc.
 - "We will pretend that our work mats are a movie theater."
 - "Let's use our pattern blocks for the chairs."
- Pass out the work mats.
- Quickly distribute the pattern blocks.

"Take six pattern blocks that are the same."

- "These will be the chairs."
- Collect the extra pattern blocks.

"When they go to the movies, every teddy will need its own chair." "How many teddies can sit in the theater?" 6

- Quickly distribute the teddy bear counters. *"Take enough teddy bears to fill your chairs." "How many did you need?"*
- Collect the extra teddy bear counters.

"How many teddies are at the movies?" 6"Two teddies went out to buy popcorn."

"How many teddies are watching the movie now?" 4
"One teddy left to use the restroom."
"How many teddies are watching the movie now?" 3
"The two teddies came back with popcorn."
"Now how many teddies are watching the movie?" 5
"The teddy came back from the restroom."
"How many teddies are watching the movie now?" 6
"The movie is over."
"All the teddies went home."
"How many teddies are at the movies now?" 0
"What happened in this story?"

- Continue to act out stories using the teddy bear counters. Ask the children to make up the stories.
- Other stories can involve riding on a bus, shopping in the supermarket, lining up at a water fountain, playing in the gym, going to the library, etc.
- Collect the pattern blocks, teddy bear counters, and work mats.
